Training Commands

ENGLISH

GERMAN

HEEL

FUSS

Walk or be at my left side (mirror image of you). Left foot leads. Give the command "heel" and walk forward. Do Not wait for the dog.

SIT

SITZ

Dog should be at your left side, facing forward, parallel to your body.

DOWN

PLATZ

Dog should down facing the same direction as handler, parallel to handler's body, both front elbows and belly touching the ground.

STAY

BLEIB

Dog does not move from position, use when moving away from your dog. Right foot leads.

COME (Recall)

HIER

Dog should come to a sitting position in front of handler.

FREE (Release Command)

FREI

No longer in command mode. Dog is free to wander about but not allowed to be disobedient.

NO!: (Correction- Stop whatever your doing)

Stern tone of voice. No shouting. Zip training collar at the same time.

Quiet: (No Barking)

Stern tone of voice. No shouting. Follow thru with obedience if dog doesn't respond.

OFF:

Use when you want the dog to get off of a chair, couch, bed, etc. (Jumping up on people).

Crate: Go inside your crate
